

EIFSC DARTFISH Policies & Procedures

Purpose:

The DARTFISH technology was purchased to be a benefit and resource to all club skaters and professional staff. The purpose of this document is to insure that all skaters and professionals have fair and equal opportunity to leverage this technology in their training/coaching regimens. These policies also are to insure the security and safety of the DARTFISH system.

Eligibility:

Skaters and coaches must be members in good standing with the Eastern Iowa Figure Skating Club to be eligible to use the DARTFISH software, computer hardware, video taping devices and any additional components. There will be no cost to eligible skaters and coaches to use DARTFISH. Non-club members are not allowed to use DARTFISH.

Policies:

- A coach is eligible to conduct a DARTFISH session, after they have completed a hands-on training session that will be conducted by an EIFSC member.
- Coaches will be given keys to the DARTFISH closet/cart upon completing the training session.
- A coach must be present for all DARTFISH sessions. The DARTFISH system is to be operated at all times by trained personnel. The safety/security of the equipment and integrity of the software/data is the responsibility of the trained person operating the system.
- To prevent theft, at all times the DARTFISH system should be attended to by trained personnel or secured in a locked location.
- A coach/parent can make a reservation for students to use DARTFISH on freestyle, club ice, home school or a lightly used public session that is allowing freestyle skating per the CRIA rink rules.
- EIFSC will have parents trained on the DARTFISH system to assist a coach as needed.
- Comparison video clips of elite skaters have been purchased by the club. Those are available for general use. The use of an EIFSC skater's video clip is strictly prohibited unless the skater, parent and coach have granted permission to do so.

Reservations:

- Reservations will be made on a sign up sheet on the club bulletin board at the CRIA.
- Each skater is limited to two 30-minute sessions per week. Reservations will be done on a monthly basis and must be made at least 2 days in advance of the session desired.
- In the event that a time slot has not been reserved and the DARTFISH system will be idle. A coach/parent can add the skaters name to the signup sheet on a first come, first serve basis on the day that the session is unreserved.
- Please indicate at the time of registration if there is a need to have a trained EIFSC parent to assist with the session.
- Session assistants will be assigned as available.
- The reserved schedule will be posted on the bulletin board at the CRIA office and on the DARTFISH closet/cart as often as necessary.
