

EIFSC Ice Rules

1. All members must initial the registration book and pay for the session *before* going on the ice.
2. All skaters who wish to have a tape played should line their tapes up by the tape player. Tapes are lined up front (first) to back (last).
3. The ice monitor will begin playing tapes five minutes into the session.
4. The ice monitor will announce the name of the person whose tape is about to be played and the name of the person whose tape will be played next. If the skater misses her/his cue, the tape will be placed at the end of the line.
5. The skater whose tape is being played has the right of way. This skater will wear the provided sash so that he/she can be identified. All other skaters must yield to this skater. The skater who is next in line should obtain the sash from the skater who has just finished skating a program.
6. After a tape is played, it will be placed at the end of the line. Once a tape has started, the tape will not be stopped or restarted.
7. An instructor may ask that the tape of a skater who is having a lesson be moved up in line. The tape will be played next, after the current tape is played or finished. An instructor may ask for a tape to be moved up in line once per skater during a single lesson. The ice monitor will only play two instructor tapes in a row, then will return to a non-lesson tape. An instructor may make two such requests during a one-hour club ice session.
8. If the session is not busy (less than five tapes submitted), the ice monitor may play tapes as needed (as requested by the skater or by the coach).
9. The following behaviors are not acceptable on the ice: kicking the ice or boards, swearing, intentionally moving into the path of a skater, laying on the ice, loud or distracting noises (including yelling and clapping), chatting on the ice for prolonged periods.
10. The EIFSC board and the skaters thank you for following these rules!

Guidelines for Ice Monitor

Your first responsibility is to check in the skaters and make sure everyone pays. All skaters need to pay before they enter the ice. **THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!** Your second responsibility is to hook up the tape machine and to play tapes according to the guidelines listed above. Announce the name of the skater whose tape you are about to play, and the name of the skater whose tape is next in line. As indicated above, coaches may cut in line once per skater per lesson. You are also responsible for enforcing the ice rules listed above. Return the registration book to the EIFSC box and return to the office. Thanks so much!
